One of the first questions I was asked when I started sharing the gospel was "Is this that religion where they dance like crazy people with the Holy Spirit?" I always answered — "Yes" because I didn't even understand it myself. I didn't know what else to say. I did not have the understanding to explain why the Holy Spirit made people dance because I had not yet had that experience. I was not raised as a Christian, and the first time I attended church was when I was fifteen—shortly after my uncle passed away. 
As the years passed, I experienced healing through prayer and saw how God
